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Scholarship Expectations

The student should:

2. Choral applicants must demonstrate advanced voice skills in their most recent performance and at time of audition.
3. Be prepared to participate in nominated school-based music activities, such as rehearsals, performances, public concerts, Speech Night, assemblies and other activities and events as notified.
4. Agree, within parameters determined by the Principal, to participate in School activities before outside engagements.
5. Show support to the leadership role that is implicit for all scholarship holders. This includes being a positive role model for younger students, displaying leadership by encouraging and supporting other girls and fostering group and School spirit. This also requires the student and parents to demonstrate overt support for the values of the School both at school and outside school.
6. Show an awareness of, and appreciation for, school life and a willingness to accept the broad range of opportunities offered at St Margaret's.
7. Be committed to the School's ethos.
