



Funding for the scholarships is provided by the St Margaret's Old Girls' Association and is available for past students for undergraduate and postgraduate study overseas for periods of 6 months or 12 months. Students in Year 12 who have organised overseas study for the following year may also apply.

Preference will be given to students studying at an overseas' tertiary Institution/University for one or more semesters. Candidates studying overseas but not at a University are also welcome to apply.

The OGA Overseas Study Scholarships provide funds of up to \$5,000 a year. The level of funding for each successful candidate is totally at the discretion of the panel, made up of the Principal and a representative of the Old Girls' Association (OGA). There will be no negotiation with applicants as to the quantum of the scholarship.

Applications for study commencing in the second semester of 2019 or the first semester of 2020 close on Friday 21 June 2019.
