Helen Meredith is a former journalist, editor and commentator with forty years experience on the Australian and international scene. With a focus on the emerging digital economy, she worked as an editor and reporter on several leading newspapers, including "The Australian", "The Financial Review", "The Financial Times", "The Sydney Morning Herald", "The Age", and as a contributing journalist to the ABC. She was also founding editor-in-chief of the international online news service "Global Flow". In addition to her role as a journalist, Helen has addressed public policy issues arising from the digital revolution, and in 1989 was involved in the establishment of Females in Information Technology and Telecommunications (FITT), the frontrunner of a national network of similar associations aimed at inspiring women to achieve their potential in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics). In 2017, Helen was inducted into the Pearcey Foundation's Hall of Fame.
