Dear St Margaret's Community

The St Margaret's Music Department is very excited to once again provide the opportunity to become a member of the St Margaret's Community Choir. You do not need any previous music experience – everybody is welcome! We are hoping to have a broad spectrum of people involved including parents, family friends, staff, old girls and current students, and also hope to have a mix of female and male voices.

The choir will be conducted by our very talented choral director, Ms Regina Brennan, who has a wealth of choral experience. She has worked at the Westminster Abbey School in London as choral conductor, vocal coach and music director and has also been heavily involved with the Australian Girls' Choir as a conductor and vocal coach. Ms Brennan has been at St Margaret's since 2011 and currently conducts *Serenata*, *Chorale* and *Encorah*, and is the Primary Music Teacher.

The choir will perform at the School's annual Choral Concert to be held at the end of Term 3 on Tuesday 18 September. The choir will also be invited to participate in the massed finale performance at *Classics in the Cathedral* on Tuesday 14 August. This is always a very special event in the School's music calendar.

The choir will rehearse on Thursday evenings in the lead up to the performances in the Arts Centre Foyer.
