Responding to an Offer

You've got an offer from QTAC...now what?

What else do I need to know?

If you conditionally accept an offer, you will need to rearrange your preferences so that any other courses you wish to be considered for sit **above** your conditionally accepted offer.
Please note; you can't conditionally accept a first preference

Contact QTAC to check if you can reactivate a previous offer or change the response to your offer.

If you enrol in a course and no longer wish to study it, withdraw from it with the institution to avoid penalties.

Check your offer email for response information - some institutions will only let you conditionally accept an offer for a short amount of time.

Some institutions may require you to enrol within a certain timeframe in order to secure your place. Check your offer email for details.



How to change QTAC preferences

You can change your preferences three times for free. There is a fee each time after this.

To change your preferences:

- Log in to your QTAC account and select 'My Application'
- Under Course Preferences, select 'view or edit preferences', then 'change preferences'
- You can add, delete or edit your preferences, or re-order them using the arrows
- Once you have made all of the changes you want, save them
- Remember that you should only 'save' when you have finished all your changes
- Don't forget to change your preferences by the due date for the offer round <https://www.qtac.edu.au/key-dates/>

Enabling programs

In an enabling program, you study a number of subjects for various purposes, such as:

- getting a selection rank
- meeting a subject prerequisite
- gaining general tertiary study skills eg assignment writing, researching, test taking
- gaining basic knowledge in a selected subject as a foundation for more in-depth study later on.

A number of institutions offer enabling programs. **Contact an institution** for a full list from individual institutions.

On successful completion of some enabling programs, you can get direct entry to selected undergraduate courses at the same institution, without having to apply through QTAC.

You can also use your enabling program from one institution to help you get into tertiary courses at another. **Check with the relevant institution** which enabling programs they accept.

Bridging study

Single-subject bridging units will not get a rank but can be used to:

- meet subject prerequisites
- gain tertiary study skills
- gain basic knowledge in a selected subject.

Check with the relevant institution which bridging studies they accept to meet subject prerequisites.

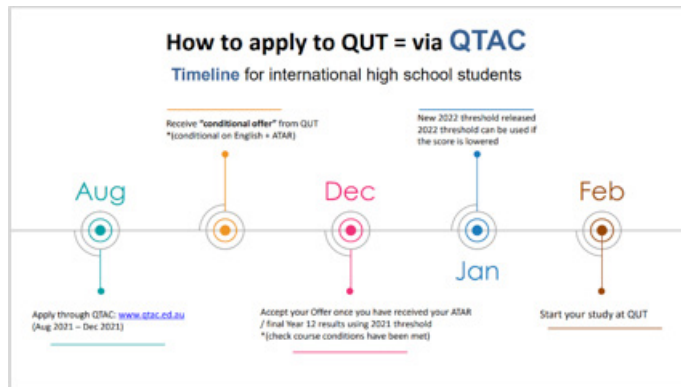
