Students will be required to bring their own instrument, music and must be in their middy. Please make sure your daughter has a packed lunch to take with her as a lunch break will be provided.

Students in Chorale, Volare and Rock Band (who are not in Sister Helen Wind Symphony, Exultate or Chamber Strings) will depart QPAC at 1:00pm, returning to school at approximately 2:00pm. Students who are in Sister Helen Wind Symphony, Exultate and Chamber Strings will depart QPAC at 2:30pm, returning to school at approximately 3:20pm.

Please note, students who normally travel home on the Gap or Bulimba buses may need to make alternate arrangements on this day, as the 2:30pm bus back to St Margaret's may not make it back in time for these buses.

Students will be required to be back at QPAC by **6:00pm** for Speech Night and will need to enter through the **backstage door**. Please note, Prize Recipients, Year 12 students and members of Primary Chorale, Volare, Exultate, Chamber Strings, Sister Helen Wind Symphony and the selected Rock Band students must be in their white church frocks for the evening's proceedings.

At the conclusion of the evening, musicians can be picked up from the backstage door from which they need to exit.
