BAPTISM and ADMISSION TO HOLY COMMUNION

In Religious and Values Education (RVE) the girls in Year 4 will be learning about the sacraments of the Church, particularly Baptism and Holy Communion. They will also gain a greater understanding of the workings of the St Margaret's School Chapel.

On Wednesday 29 April at 6.00 pm, the Primary Year 4-6 Family Service will be held in St Margaret's Chapel. It will be a service of Holy Communion and any member of the school community from **Year 4 and above** who would like to be formally admitted into holy communion (to receive bread and wine) is invited to complete the attached form. The prerequisite is that they are already **baptised**. There will be an opportunity to be baptised during this service prior to being admitted to communion, for anyone who wishes to be baptised at school.

Girls who are already communicant members of their own Christian denominations and are baptised (christened) in their own traditions are not required to be admitted to either sacrament anew. They will be invited to take communion whenever the Eucharist is celebrated at school.

Please complete the attached form if you wish your daughter, or other family members, to be Baptised or admitted to Holy Communion and return it to the Primary Office no later than **Monday 9 March**. If you wish to have your daughter/child baptised as well as admitted to Holy Communion, please indicate this on the form.

Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any queries regarding this process. Being Admitted to Communion is *not the same as* Confirmation – a more adult commitment that happens from the aged of 13 in the Anglican Church.
