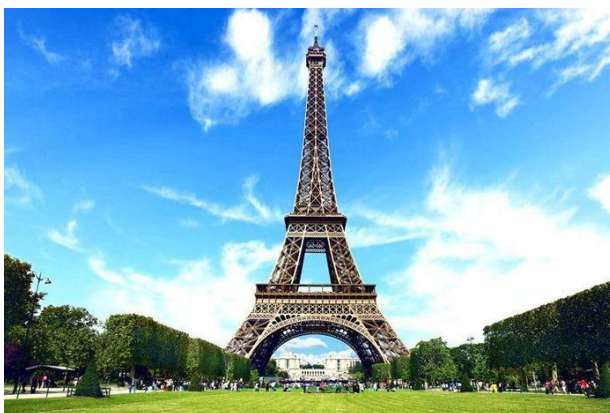

Why Tour?

Touring is an amazing way for us to be challenged, to gain deeper insights, greater inspiration and more powerful motivation in our studies

Touring inspires us to explore, experiment and experience things beyond the everyday, producing an open and searching mind

When we tour, everyone grows in personal confidence and becomes more self-reliant, organised and responsible. We learn to be more independent, expand our horizons and become globally aware

Why a Music Tour?

Music is a FINE ART (not an industry, nor a consumable product, nor simply entertainment):

- It speaks symbolically, therefore powerfully about us
- It creates enduring statements about who we are to future generations: what we believe, what we value, how we live, our priorities, culture and civilisation
- It is inseparable from its own culture, history, place and time
- It is inextricably linked to painting, sculpture, poetry and architecture
- It is completely entwined with religion, philosophy, politics and economics

We tour to experience and perform music in new and amazing places which we cannot do at home

We tour as Australians to share with others our unique understanding of music

Through a music tour - the preparation for it and the experiences gained while away – each performer, each ensemble and the entire music program grows in inspiration, motivation, stature and quality in a way that cannot be achieved in other ways

- Evening departure from Brisbane flying one stop enroute to Paris

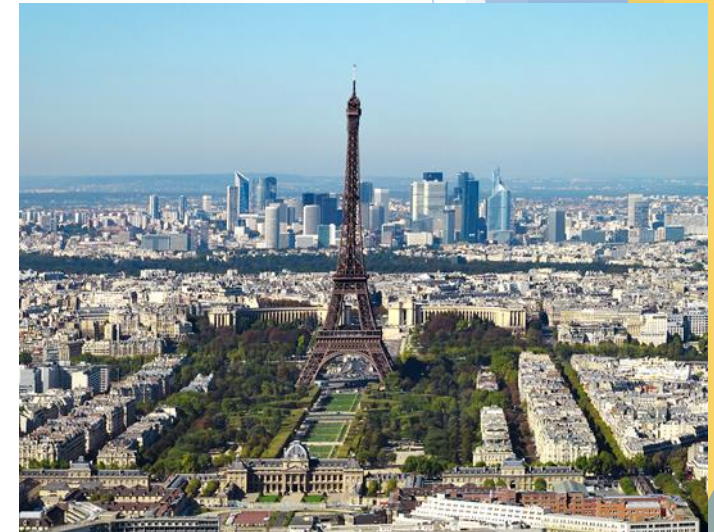




DAY 2 Paris

Paris and Ypres:

- Return economy class airfares: Brisbane / Paris...surface... Brussels / Brisbane (with 1 stop each direction)

- Exclusive coach for 5 days including airport transfers in Paris & Belgium, sightseeing in Paris on day of arrival, transfer & sightseeing between Paris and Ypres & two days coach services in Ypres

- 2 day metro pass in Paris for local transportation
