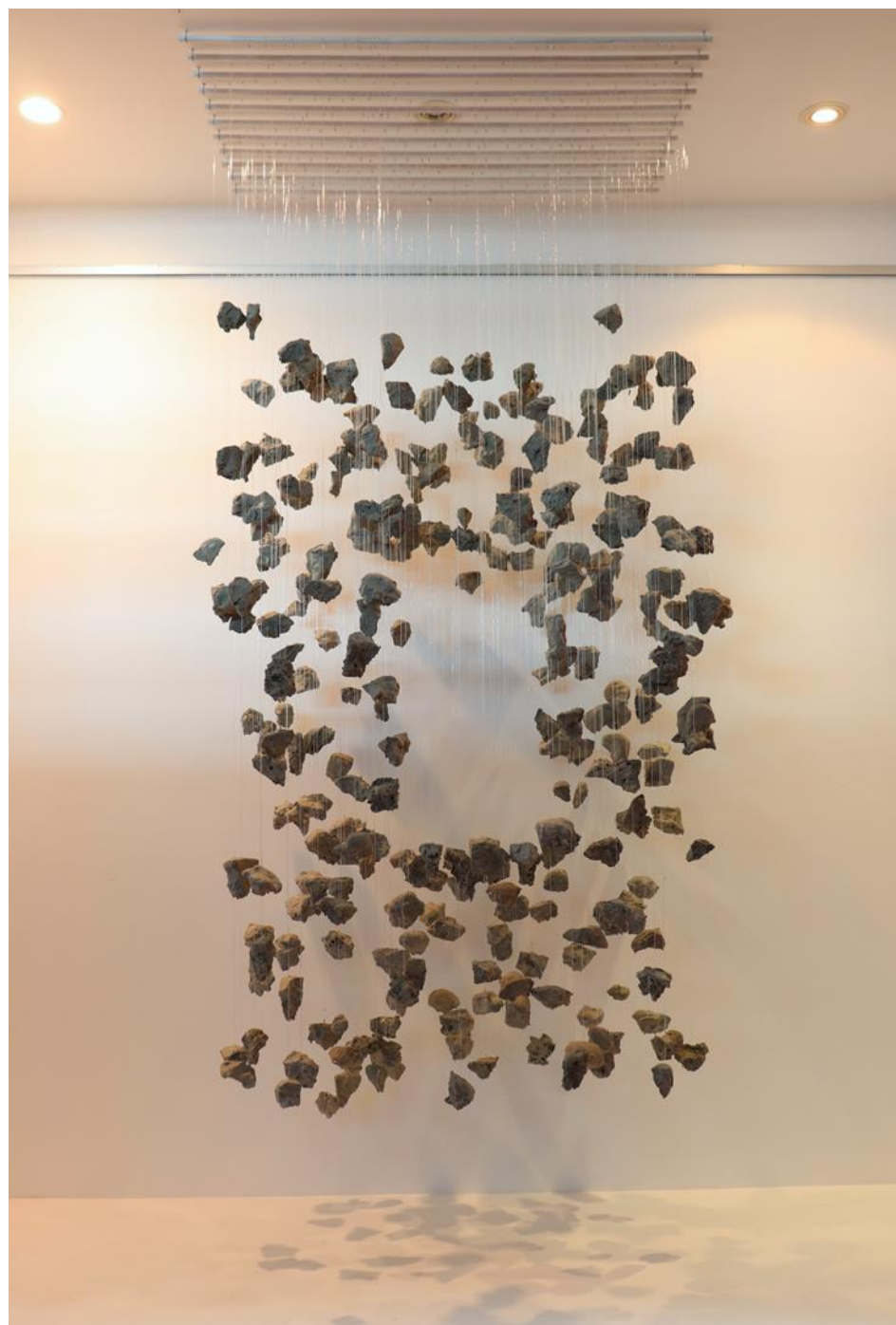
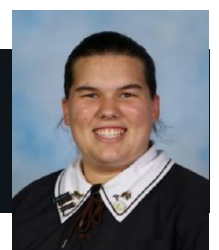

### Congratulations to Mackenzie O'Brien (Year 12) "Artwork of the Month"



*This month, we have given the Visual Art Captains a break and teachers have awarded the "Artwork of the Month".*

'Integration' consists of 300 small, cement forms suspended from the ceiling, composed in a way that manipulates positive and negative space to construct a rectangular form.

The rectangular form is representative of the concealed spaces within the many shipping containers at the Port of Brisbane. This form is visible in its completeness only when audiences place themselves in particular viewing positions, making what is concealed within the work only visible upon more considered observation. 'Integration' manipulates space and form in ways that challenge audience perspective and reveal that which is concealed. Mackenzie's work is a thoughtful response to the Port of Brisbane Visual Art excursion undertaken by the Year 12 class as stimulus for the current unit of work. Well done Mackenzie!
