This event will be held on Saturday 15 May at Rivermount College, Rivermount Drive, Yatala, from 7.15am to 1.30pm. Support at inter-school sporting events is an integral part of school life providing students with significant opportunities to become involved in the school community.

The School will provide transport to and from Rivermount College. Buses will depart from Butler Street at 7.15am and return by approximately 1.30pm. Parents are welcome to collect their daughter from Rivermount College at the conclusion of the event. Please ensure your daughter has her name marked off when leaving the event.
