Jewellery with Clare Poppi

Clare Poppi is an artist living and working in Brisbane. Clare works in jewellery and metal-smithing, focusing on sustainable design and wearable art.

Who: Open to all secondary students in Years 7-12. Max class size 10.

What: Students will learn to use metal stamping tools to create pattern and text on silver and copper jewellery. Over six weeks students will use these skills in addition to traditional silversmithing techniques to make a silver ring and pendant (or cuff) and other items if time permits. The class will focus on mandalas and pattern-making, along with thoughtful inclusions of words and text.
