In 2005, Waverley Stanley and his wife Llew Mullins established Yalari, a not-for-profit organisation. Their mission was to empower young Indigenous children from regional, rural and remote areas of Australia through education.

Now, 13 years later, Yalari has 186 Indigenous students on boarding school scholarships nationally and 313 alumni who are studying at university, working or undertaking further training. There are currently 12 students on Yalari scholarships at St Margaret's Anglican Girls School.
