

The Music Program at St Margaret's aims to inspire students to make music an integral part of their lives. Students have the opportunity to participate in many different music ensembles, ranging from string and band groups, to choirs and rock bands. Many performance opportunities are provided throughout the year. These include school concerts, an annual performance in St John's Cathedral - 'Classics in the Cathedral', the school musical, competitions, community events, interschool festivals and local church services. Students may also choose to participate in music camps and international tours that occur at regular intervals.
