An approved **COVID Safe Event Plan** is in place for this event. In accordance with the plan, when you arrive at the event, you will need to register via EVA check-in on your smart phone.

All guests will also need to adhere to the following restrictions:

- all attendees will be required to physical distance (1.5m)
- all attendees will be required to use hand sanitiser upon entering the event
- no person should attend if they have, in the last 14 days, travelled from overseas or a declared COVID-19 hotspot or had close contact with a person who is positive for COVID-19, or are COVID-19 positive themselves
- no person should attend if they are or have recently experienced fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, fatigue, diarrhoea, vomiting or nausea, loss of smell and/or taste.

St Margaret's can refuse right of entry if anyone is displaying symptoms or refuses to adhere to the above COVID-safe

measures.

If you become unwell with symptoms including fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, fatigue, diarrhoea, vomiting or nausea, loss of smell and/or taste during , please alert a St Margaret's staff member. You will be directed to an isolated area within the school Health Centre where a nurse will assess your symptoms.
